

Summer Science Experience

Explore weather and climate at Mizzou



A summer science experience for high school students will be conducted during the summer of 2005 on the campus of the University of Missouri-Columbia. **Weather Academy 2005** at the Mizzou Atmospheric Science Program will guide 10-15 junior and senior high students through a study of the Earth's weather and climate during 2 weeks, from June 13 to June 24, 2005.

Activities will include:

Classroom instruction

Visit a National Weather Service office

Examine cases of severe weather

Visit the Aviation Weather Center

Participate in research projects on winter thunderstorms ("thundersnow") and education

Access the WAV computer weather lab

Visit an Air Force base weather station

South Farm Field Station experiments

Visit a television studio weather lab

Who is Eligible?

Students who will be entering 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grades during Fall 2005 are eligible to apply for the program.

Completed applications must be received by April 15, 2005.
